GENERAL VOTING DAY will be open to qualified electors of the District of Lillooet on **Saturday, March 17, 2012**, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. at the District of Lillooet Municipal Office, 615 Main Street, Lillooet, BC.

Elector Registration

There is no need to pre-register to vote as the registration of all electors for this election will take place at the time of voting. You will be required to make a declaration that you meet the following requirements:

- You are 18 years of age;
- You are a Canadian citizen;
- You have been a resident of BC for at least 6 months immediately preceding the day of registration;
- You have been a resident of OR have been the registered owner of real property in the District of Lillooet for at least 30 days immediately preceding the day of registration; and
- You are not otherwise disqualified by law from voting.

Resident electors will also be required to produce **2 pieces of identification** (at least one with a signature). Picture identification is not necessary. The identification must prove both residency and identity.

Non-resident property electors must produce 2 pieces of identification (at least one with a signature) to prove identity, proof that they are entitled to register in relation to the property (only a copy of property title, registered agreement for sale or 99 year lease document will be accepted – tax or assessment documents are **not** acceptable), and, if applicable, written consent from the other property owners.

Advance Voting Opportunities

Advance voting will be open to qualified electors of the District of Lillooet on Wednesday, March 7, 2012, from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. in Room 201 at the Lillooet R.E.C. Centre, 930 Main Street, Lillooet, BC.

Special Voting Opportunity

A special voting opportunity will be available on Friday, March 16, 2012, as follows:

- Mountainview Lodge from 10:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.
- Lillooet Hospital from 11:15 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.
- Red Rock Manor from 2:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m.

Only those qualified electors who are residents, patients or staff of the Special Voting Locations at the time of voting may vote at this special voting opportunity.

Mail Ballots

Mail Ballots have been authorized for the following voters:

- Persons who have a physical disability, illness or injury that affects their ability to vote at another voting opportunity, and
- Persons who expect to be absent from the municipality on general voting day and the times of all advance voting opportunities.

Registration for mail ballots begins on February 29, 2012 and ends at 4:00 p.m. on March 15, 2012.

It is the responsibility of the elector to ensure the ballot is returned by the close of voting on March 17, 2012. Ballots received after the close of voting will not be accepted.
